With reference to the subject cited above and minutes under reference, all the BPMs are hereby directed to facilitate the VPICs in procurement of materials required for construction works. In this regard, the applicable guidelines for procurement of materials are given below for your ready reference and necessary action.

Above ₹ 2,50,000/-	Submitted to SPMU.  Procurement of goods would be facilitated by SPMU.

For every purchase above ₹ 25,000/- (rupees twenty-five thousand only) upto ₹ 2,50,000/- (rupees two lakks fifty thousand only), BPMs should facilitate the VPICs for identification of suitable vendors. BPMs should shortlist at least three vendors and share the price lists offered by them to the VPICs and also to the SPMU. However, VPICs may choose to procure from a vendor other than the shortlisted vendors if the materials can be procured at a lower price than the prices offered by the shortlisted vendors.
